













PUPPY CLUB - HOW IT WORKS

-  Payment is CASH ONLY at the Puppy Club Park gate.
-  This club can only work if everyone understands and adheres to the Puppy Club Rules & Park Etiquette. The etiquette and rules are in place so you and your puppy can get the most out of the socialization experience.
-  We have reserved a private off leash park at Place 4 Paws, Airdrie. <https://www.theplace4paws.com/play-unleashed>. This is an outdoor, fenced, large dog park with many options to keep our distance and enjoy your experience.
-  This is Alberta and while our weather is anyone's guess, it should not stop us. We will learn in all kinds of weather unless there is a safety concern and we need to postpone or cancel. -  We will be waiting at the chain-link gate when you come and get you set up to go into the park. We will then direct you to a play area to start in with your puppy. Upon entering the play area, please remove your puppy's collar and harness.
-  We will direct where and what group all the different puppies will work in best. We may move puppies to different groups matching their energy and play style. We ask that owners stay with their puppies to observe. We will ensure puppies are comfortable with who is in their group and the play is safe. We may make several changes and ask you to move around so that we can make sure your puppy is always benefiting from play and not getting overwhelmed or frightened at any time.
-  Be ready to move around so your puppy gets used to looking for you, reward your puppy each and every time they return to you. Interrupt your puppy intermittently by calling them back to you
-  Interrupt your puppy immediately if they are over aroused/stressed by placing a treat in front of their nose and luring them away from the play and providing, love, treats and lots of praise when they follow you.
-  Pick up your puppy's poops immediately.
-  If your puppy is tired, it is time to take your puppy home. We can help you to identify these signs as we observe. These are young learners and we need to respect their limits.
